

**Religious Education (RE) - LEVEL 5 - Year 3 –
Learning Outcomes to be assessed at Year 3 level**

I can:

- identify and reflect on three key values, including respect, I need to develop in order to live harmoniously within a community, even with those who have different beliefs from me.

I can:

- name the sacred books and the places of worship of the Christians/Catholics, of Jewish and Muslim faith communities and develop respect for their significance.

I can:

- describe the meaning of a symbol, identify and name Christian/Catholic, Jewish and Muslim symbols, explaining their importance to their followers.

I can:

- write short prayers, praying for myself and others, whilst acknowledging that when I pray, I am speaking with God.

I can:

- identify instances of beauty; *for instance: in objects, places, sounds and persons*, and acknowledge that all beauty is initiated by God.

I can:

- show respect and esteem for the dignity of the Bible as the written Word of God, who is the Creator of the world and humanity.

I can:

- retell the Christmas story and reflect on both the personal significance and that for humanity as a whole, of the birth of Jesus, Son of God and Mary.

I can:

- describe the love for Jesus of a particular saint, and his/her love for his/her neighbour, especially the poor and the sick.

- explain and evaluate the need of forgiveness in my life and how I show love to others.
